The Chairman Senate extended a warm welcome to all the Senate members for attending the 13<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting of the Institute with special thanks to Prof. Rowena Robinson, Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, IIT Bombay, member of the Senate for sparing her time in a very busy schedule, while on visit to IIT Guwahati. The Chairman in his speech also informed the Senate about a special initiative by IITs to increase the number of female students in IIT B.Tech. program.

In this regard, IIT Mandi took lead to counsel female candidates before the choice filling. Over 7000 emails were sent to prospective female candidates by Prof. Gonsalves, Chair of JAB Sub-committee for recommending measures to increase female students in IIT B.Tech. program, to attract them to join IITs. IIT Mandi and several other IITs are also setting up special helpdesks for female candidates this year. Through these activities, IIT Mandi is hoping to increase the female enrollment from the current 4% in first year B.Tech. to at least 12% or so.

The Senate confirmed the minutes of its 12<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2017.

**Item No. 13.2:** To receive a Report on the actions taken to implement the decisions of the 12<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2017.

The Senate noted the action taken on its earlier decisions.

**Item No. 13.3:** To consider the Ordinances and Regulations of B.Tech./ B.Tech Honours Programme.

The Board of Academics in its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 deliberated on and recommended the Ordinances and Regulations of the B.Tech./B.Tech. Honors programmes for consideration of the Senate.

The Senate considered the Ordinances & Regulations of the B.Tech/B.Tech Honours Programme and suggested a few modifications. The Senate also authorized the Chairman, Senate to approve the modified proposal of Ordinances and Regulations of B.Tech/B.Tech (Honours) programmes, once the suggested changes have been incorporated. While discussing on Ordinances & Regulations of B.Tech Programmes, Senate suggested to use different course codes for MTP of different branches. CPC can suggest appropriate codes for MTP of different branches for the consideration of Chairman, Senate. The Senate authorized Chairman, Senate to approve the revised codes. For B.Tech. (Honours), a student must do MTP in his/her own branch.

The revised version of the Ordinances and Regulations after incorporating the suggested changes is enclosed as **Annexure - A**.

**Item No. 13.4:** To consider new courses recommended by the Course Proposal Committee (CPC) and Board of Academics (BoA):

The Senate considered the course proposals and recommendations of the CPC. After deliberations, the Senate advised the Chairperson, CPC to incorporate the specific suggestions/comments given for certain course proposals. The Senate also authorized the Chairman, Senate to approve the new course proposals after modifications, on behalf of the Senate.

The revised version of the course proposals after incorporating the suggested changes is enclosed as **Annexure -B**.

The Senate also suggested to change the course name of DP301P: Inter-disciplinary Socio-Technical Practicum to DP301P: Interactive Socio-Technical Practicum, as the former name was not reflecting the purpose and content of the course. This change shall be effective from the Academic Year 2017-18 onwards.

**Item No. 13.5: To consider the Campus Placement and Internship Policy of the Institute.**

A proposal regarding Institute Policy for Campus Placement and Internship has been received for consideration of the Senate.

The Senate considered the Campus Placement and Internship Policy of the Institute and suggested a few modifications. The Senate authorized the Chairman, Senate to approve the modified Campus Placement and Internship Policy of the Institute after incorporating suggested changes on behalf of the Senate.

The revised version of the Campus Placement and Internship Policy of the Institute is enclosed as **Annexure - C**.

**Item No. 13.6: To consider the Recommendations of the JAB Sub-Committee for Increasing Female Enrolment in B.Tech. in IITs, already accepted by IIT Council in its Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2017.**

The IIT Council in its 51<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 has considered and accepted the recommendations of the JAB Sub-Committee for Increasing Female Enrolment in B.Tech. in IITs. The Sub-Committee was Chaired by Dr. Timothy A. Gonsalves, Director, IIT Mandi alongwith participation of 17 other Members and Invitees. The proposal was placed before the Senate for consideration and adoption.

The Senate appreciated the efforts made by the Sub-Committee chaired by Prof. T. A. Gonsalves. After due deliberations, the Senate accepted the recommendations of the JAB Sub-Committee and decided to implement the same at IIT Mandi and suggested

that a special scholarship should be adopted for the female B.Tech. students. It was noted that IIT Mandi is already awarding a scholarship to all female students in 1<sup>st</sup> year–B.Tech, and to those in Mechanical and Electrical Engineering in 2<sup>nd</sup> year B.Tech. To kick start the activities, Senate deliberated and decided to modify the scholarship as follows: a merit scholarship to all the female B.Tech. students joining IIT Mandi from the Academic Year 2017-18 onwards including full tuition fee waiver and Rs. 1,000/- per month stipend . This merit scholarship will continue till 4<sup>th</sup> year subject to good academic performance of the candidate indicated by a minimum SGPA criteria of 7.0 for the previous two semesters and no disciplinary action. Also, the Senate approved the suggestion of assigning the responsibility to a Dean to monitor the gender aspects at IIT Mandi.
