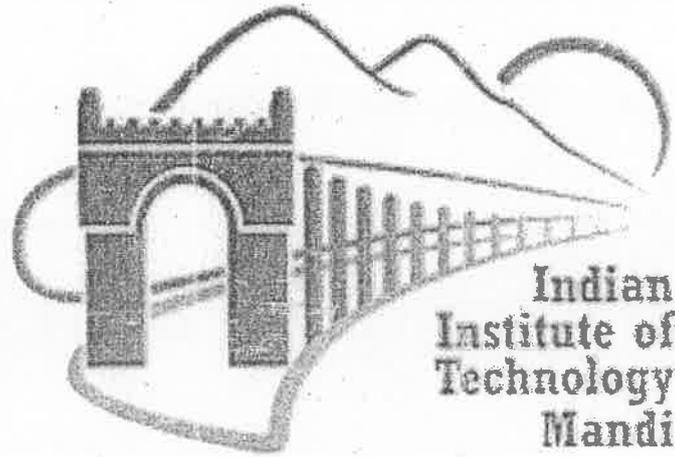

The Chairman extended a warm welcome to the members for making themselves available for IIT Senate meeting in person or through Video Conference. He highly appreciated efforts made by Execom Conveners in executing the decisions taken during the last Senate meeting.

Then the agenda points were taken up.

Item No. 3.1: To confirm the minutes of the 2nd Ad-hoc Senate meeting held on 23rd May, 2012

The minutes of the 2nd Ad-hoc Senate meeting held on 23rd May 2012 at IIT Mandi were confirmed.

Item No. 3.2: To receive a Report on the action taken to implement the decisions of the 2nd Ad-hoc Senate meeting held on 23rd May, 2012.

The position of action taken on the matters as reported was noted.

Item No. 3.3: To consider introduction of M.Sc/M.Tech programmes at IIT Mandi.

Introduction of new M.Sc./M.Tech programmes at IIT Mandi was discussed. The five courses suggested were Energy Systems, Environmental and Civil Engineering, Materials Science, Nano

technology and Sustainable Systems. It was decided that only the courses which have a significant job prospectives may be started. Faculty members were asked to formulate the proposals and discuss in their respective Schools for consideration by the next Senate meeting.

Item No. 3.4: To consider Bio-related research activities at IIT Mandi.

The Senate discussed starting of biology related activities at IIT Mandi, especially in Systems and Synthetic Biology. It was decided that introduction of various biology related disciplines at IIT Mandi may be discussed in the next Senate meeting. The Senate also recommended for approval by BoG procurement of following equipment:-

Item No. 3.5: Additional agenda items with the permission of the Chair.

Four new course proposals and four new minor proposals were taken up with the permission of the Chair.

New course proposals

- 1) CS 606 - Cognitive Modeling,
- 2) CS 203 - Discrete Structures,
- 3) HS 502 - Philosophy of Technology.

4) HS601- Research Methodology for the Humanities & Social Sciences

Senate discussed each of these courses in detail and approved the following three courses

- 1) CS606
- 2) CS 203 and
- 3) HS 502 in principle.

Appropriate suggestions were given to modify the contents of these courses. It was decided that the Chairman, Senate can approve these courses on behalf of the Senate, after incorporating the modifications suggested. In the case of HS 601, it was noted that there is already a Research Methodology course in proposal addressing students from all schools. Therefore, Senate was of the opinion that a separate Research Methodology course for HSS students is not necessary presently. In future such a course may be proposed when the institute grows bigger and more HSS research scholars are admitted.

After revisions, the course code of CS 606- Cognitive Modeling is changed to CS 506- Cognitive modeling. The modified course proposals of CS506, CS203, HS502 are approved by Chairman, Senate on behalf of Senate. The modified course syllabi are given in Appendix 1.

New minor proposals

The following four minor proposals were presented in the Senate for discussions and approval.

- 1) Minor in Mechanical Design
- 2) Minor in Thermo-fluid Systems
- 3) Minor in German Language
- 4) Minor in Machine Learning

The Senate discussed these minor proposals in detail and approved these proposals in principle. Appropriate suggestions were given by Senate to improve each proposal. It was decided that the minor proposals need to be resubmitted to the Chairman, Senate after incorporating the suggestions received from Senate. Chairman, Senate can approve these proposals on behalf of the Senate. After revision, the title of Minor in Machine Learning was changed to Minor in Intelligent Systems.

The modified Minor proposals are approved by Chairman, Senate on behalf of Senate. The modified course syllabi are given in Appendix 2.

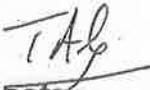
Item No. 3.6:

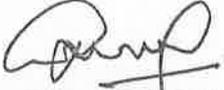
To report decisions / action taken by Chairman, Senate.
