The final/modified courses descriptions details are enclosed as Annexure – A; Page No. 6 to 45.

Further, the Senate deliberated and decided to drop the proposal for the course ME-512 (Advanced Engineering Mathematics). It was noted that the proposed course contents are very similar to the contents of the basic mathematics courses being offered as part of the B.Tech. programme of IIT Mandi and other similar institutes. In this regard, some senate members pointed out that many of our M.Tech students are weak in fundamentals of mathematics and such a course would be really helpful for them. They also pointed out that some IITs offer such a course for their M.Tech students. Considering all these points, Senate decided that the course in its current form cannot be accepted for M.Tech program. The course content should be checked for similarity with the contents of the B.Tech. mathematics courses and there should be substantial difference in terms of the contents (more than 50%) if the proposer wish to resubmit the proposal through proper channel.

Taking a view on the students who are weak in mathematics, the Senate suggested that remedial courses may be offered for such students, but those courses cannot be counted for CGPA calculations.

Item No. 16.4: To consider a proposal for M. Tech. in Structural Engineering.

On the recommendations of the Board of Academics, the Senate considered the proposal for a new program 'M. Tech. in Structural Engineering'. After deliberations, the Senate approved the new programme proposal with a few suggested modifications to start the program from the Academic year 2018-19.

The revised version of the proposal incorporating the suggested changes is enclosed as Annexure - B; Page No. 46 to 57.

Item No. 16.5: To consider a proposal for M. Tech. in VLSI.

On the recommendations of the Board of Academics, the Senate considered the proposal for a new program 'M. Tech. in VLSI'. After deliberations, the Senate approved the new programme proposal after modifications to start the program from the Academic year 2018-19.

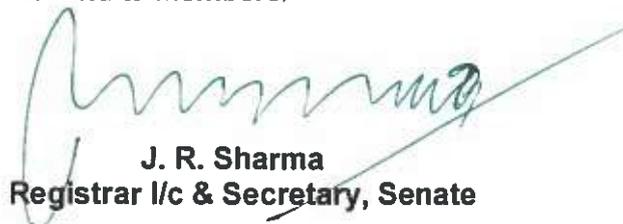
The senate noted the decisions taken by the Chairman Senate on behalf of the Senate.
