The Chairman Senate extended a warm welcome to all the Senate members and faculty for attending the 10th Senate meeting. He welcomed Mr. Ajay, Student Research Affairs Secretary and placed on record the appreciable services rendered by Mr. C. Thirumurgan outgoing Student Research Affairs Secretary. He also welcomed the new faculty members who joined IIT Mandi after the last Senate meeting.

The Chairman informed the Senate that the Institute has decided to offer the courses approved by the Senate hence this meeting has been convened. He also informed that we are becoming like older IITs to approve the courses before its start. He advised that use of Open Office may be encouraged when the information is circulated within the Institute.

Then the agenda items were taken up.

Item No. 10.1: To confirm the minutes of the 9th Senate meeting held on 11th May, 2016.

The Senate confirmed the minutes of its 9th meeting held on 11th May, 2016.

Item No. 10.2: To receive a Report on the actions taken to implement the decisions of the 9th Senate meeting held on 11th May, 2016.

The Senate noted the action taken report on implementation of decisions taken in its 9th meeting held on 11th May, 2016.

Item No. 10.3: To consider revised proposal for M. Tech. in Mechanical Engineering with Specialization in Energy Systems.

The Senate deliberated on the proposal for M.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering with Specialization in Energy Systems and suggested modifications in the course curriculum & structure.

The Senate authorized Chairman, Senate to approve the proposal once the suggested changes are incorporated.

Revised versions of the proposal incorporating the suggested changes is given in Annexure A.

Item No. 10.4: To consider the curriculum of I-Ph.D. (Physics) programme:

The Senate considered the curriculum of Integrated-Ph.D. (Physics) and approved the course curriculum and structure with suggested changes.

The Senate authorized Chairman, Senate to approve the proposal once the suggested changes are incorporated.

The Senate also suggested to review the scholarship component of the program and frame a policy for it and to submit it separately to the Chairman, Senate for approval.

Revised versions of the proposal incorporating the suggested changes is given in Annexure B & C.

Item No. 10.5: Presentation by the Course Proposal Committee (CPC) Chair

The CPC chair presented the new course proposals for the approval of Senate. Also proposals for changes in course credits, course name/code etc of some of the Senate approved courses were also presented. Senate considered the proposals and recommendation of the CPC in detail and specific suggestions/comments were given for certain courses to modify the proposals.

Senate authorized Chairman, Senate to approve the new course proposals after modifications, if any, on behalf of Senate.

Revised versions of the proposals incorporating the suggested changes is given in Annexure D & E.

Item No. 10.6: To consider the guidelines for Conversion from JRF to SRF under HTRA Fellowship

The Senate deliberated on and approved the guidelines for the conversion of JRF to SRF under HTRA fellowship scheme with below mentioned changes:

- The student should have secured CGPA 7.5.
- The student should not be under investigation for any act of indiscipline or there should not be any 'active' disciplinary probation/warning on him/her.

- If a student is found not suitable for recommending for SRF, another chance can be given to the student after a period of 6 months.
- The quality and quantity of research done by the student should be evidenced by the Doctoral Committee.

A revised version of the proposal incorporating the above suggested changes is given in Annexure F.

Item No. 10.7 Introduction of B.Tech (Honors) programme:

The Senate considered and approved the proposal for introduction of new B.Tech. (Honors) programme in all the branches of Technology with the following eligibility requirements:

- a. A student may opt for B.Tech. (Honors) programme if she/he has CGPA of 8.5 or more and no 'F' grade till fourth or fifth semester.
- b. For B. Tech (Honors), a student needs to earn additional 12 credits (over and above the required 160 credits for B. Tech degree) relevant to her/his discipline as recommended by the faculty advisor.
- c. Student should do MTP compulsorily and obtain a grade of 'B' or above in both the 7th and 8th Semesters.
- d. Student should not have received 'F' grade throughout the B.Tech. program.
- e. Student should secure an overall CGPA of 8.5 or more out of 172 credits (160+12).

The Senate decided to provide an opportunity for B.Tech 2013 batch students to opt for B. Tech (Honors) if they wish to do so.

The Senate authorized Associate Dean (Courses) to approve the applications of the students opting for the B.Tech. (Honors) programme.

Item No. 10.8: Additional agenda item with the permission of the Chair

(b.i) Distribution of 160 credits across all eight semesters:

The Senate considered some of the recommendations presented in 9th Senate regarding the guidelines for distribution of 160 credits across all eight semesters of the B.Tech Program. After due deliberation, the Senate approved the following:

- Each B. Tech student must register for a minimum of 12 credits every semester. He/She may register for maximum of 22 credits in a semester. Relaxation to this will be given only under special circumstances.

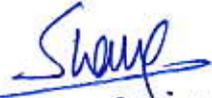
