

The Chairman Senate extended a warm welcome to all the Senate members and faculty for attending the 7th Senate meeting. He welcomed Mr. Mohammad Shakeel, Registrar and Secretary to Senate, who joined the Institute in December 2014 and appreciated the appreciable services rendered by Dr. R. C. Sawhney, outgoing Registrar and first Secretary to the Senate. He also welcomed the new faculty members who joined IIT Mandi after the last Senate meeting.

The Chairman noted that preparations for the visit of the Honourable President of India for the 2nd Convocation on 15th March are in full swing. While many faculty and staff are working hard to make it a success, he especially appreciated Prof. S. C. Jain, Dean (I & S) for his efforts almost around the clock for the past many weeks, along with the Registrar, towards the organization of this event.

He informed the members that IIT Mandi is the first among the new IITs to shift to the permanent campus. Around 65% students of IIT Mandi have already been shifted to its permanent campus in Kamand. Three new hostel buildings will be ready soon and about 85% of the students will be shifted to the Kamand campus this semester itself. Currently about 40% faculty members have been shifted to the Kamand campus and the remaining will be shifted possibly by the end of this year. New labs, library,

campus school etc are coming up soon in the permanent campus and the play grounds are also getting ready.

He further informed the members that during the last six months, Institute has recruited six new faculty members in BioX. This new batch of faculty will develop the research and teaching facilities in BioX in the coming years. One of our major achievements is to introduce Civil Engineering branch in the Institute. Towards this, a series of work-shops have been conducted over the last few months. The first brainstorming workshop on civil engineering was organized in April 2014 which was chaired by Prof. V. S. Raju. This was followed by a 2nd work-shop in October, 2014 and a 3rd work-shop in March 2015. Experts from TU9 Institutions, Germany and other IITs participated in these work-shops to give directions to the new Civil Engineering program.

Chairman reminded that the two major expectations from IIT faculty are research and teaching. Here at IIT Mandi, the teaching is taken seriously. He stressed on the importance of students' feed-back in improving the teaching standards. Chairman advised the student representatives to convey the message to all the students to actively participate in teacher course feedback process. He also announced that a Teaching Workshop has been organized at IIT Mandi in collaboration with IIT Madras and few of our faculty members have attended this workshop. Some other faculty members attended a similar workshop held at IIT Madras. He expressed the view that the students will be benefitted from the experiences the faculty members earned from these workshops.

In August, 2014 a new Academic body called the 'Board of Academics' (BoA) was constituted. This body is below the Senate and is expected to take-up academic related issues and give its suggestions and recommendations to the Senate. BoA consists mostly of young faculty members which provides a platform to the new faculty and students to express their views.

The Chairman informed that IIT Mandi has currently about 150 research scholars. Our research output has increased substantially over the last year. We have published a number of journal articles over the last year which amounts to 2.33 per faculty member. He noted that this number is even higher than that of some of the older IITs. Also he noted that three of our MS students have been converted to PhD, including 2 female PhDs in Mechanical Engineering, which again is a good sign and shows our strength in research. IIT Mandi has received substantial research grants over the last year for various sponsored research projects. Dr. Varun Dutt has got an industrial project from USA for USD 95,000 which is the second largest industrial project received by the Institute in terms of funds.

Item No. 7.4: Presentation by the CPC Chair

Dr. Bharat Singh Rajpurohit, Chairperson, CPC presented the modified CPC procedures to the Senate. He also presented a new course proposal titled 'Text Retrieval and Mining' for Senate's approval. Senate members gave their comments on the proposal and requested the proposer to revise the proposal accordingly. Once the corrections have been incorporated, the Chairman, Senate can approve the proposal on behalf of the Senate. The revised syllabus of this course is attached in Annexure A.

Item No. 7.5: To consider creation of a JEE (Advanced) Office/Cell at IIT Mandi

Chairman Senate briefed the members about JEE processes and requested the Senate to approve the cell. Senate after discussing all the aspects of the issues has approved the creation of JEE Cell in the Institute Chaired by Dr. Pradeep C. Parameswaran, Assoc. Dean(Courses).

Item No. 7.6: Introduction of a new B.Tech. degree programme

- The programme of B.Tech. in Civil Engineering is being recommended by the Senate for approval by the Board of Governors. (Annexure-A1)
- The Senate recommended a strength of 25 students as the intake in B.Tech, Civil Engineering programme for the forth-coming Academic Year for kind approval of BOG.

Item No. 7.7: Courses taken by non-degree students

Currently, in the M.S. (by Research) degree certificate only the thesis title is mentioned; the School or discipline is not mentioned. Mentioning only the topic of the research may narrow down the students' career options including choice of areas for Ph.D. research. Therefore, after deliberations, the Senate recommended for the approval by the Board of Governors (BOG) for inclusion of the name of School also in the M.S. (by Research) degree.

Item No. 7.8: Additional agenda items with the permission of the Chair.

Semester Away:

Prof. Ramesh Oruganti, Dean(Academics) raised an additional agenda item, which was recommended by Board of Academics in its last meeting. Chairman Senate allowed to present this item to the Senate. The details of this agenda item are as follows:

IIT Mandi has an active semester exchange program with eminent institutions in India and abroad. Many B. Tech students go for semester exchange visits to other institutions with which IIT Mandi has a relevant MoU. The benefits of such a programme are mainly two-fold.

1. Broadening of the educational experience of the student. Visit to another country/institution, new cultural and academic learning benefits the student's long term development. This is to be encouraged.

2. Another benefit of such visits is that the students who go on such exchange visits come back and share their experiences with their fellow students and also with faculty members leading to the broadening and enhancement of the academic culture of the parent institute.

It was observed that some of the students who go for such exchange visits spend

their last two semesters (7th and 8th semesters) outside IIT Mandi due to various reasons. Because of this, IIT Mandi does not get the complete advantage of their semester exchange experiences.

One suggestion to address this problem was that the students may be allowed to go on exchange visits for only one semester at a time and they should come back and spend at least one semester at IIT Mandi before going on for another semester exchange visit.

But the student representatives and some faculty members felt that this will not be a good solution due to various reasons including the particular sequencing of courses offered during odd and even semesters at some institutes, financial implications to the students etc. Senate felt that some of these points raised by student representatives and others are valid.

Considering the pros and cons of various options, and also considering that the IIT Mandi B.Tech programme is a four year residential programme with features that are unique to the programme, the Senate decided the following:

- The student can go on exchange visits for one or two semesters.
- If the student goes on semester exchange visits for two semesters, these two semesters can be contiguous.
- No student exchange visit will be allowed during the eighth semester. The student must spend the eighth semester of his/her B.Tech program at IIT Mandi.
- Some of the 'signature courses' of IIT Mandi such as Reverse Engineering course, Design Practicum and other courses should be compulsorily completed at IIT Mandi. This is so as to preserve the character of an IIT Mandi B.Tech degree.
- The semester exchange programmes can only be undertaken with those institutes with whom IIT Mandi has an MoU for such visits.

Item No. 7.9: To report decisions / action taken by Chairman, Senate

The position of following matters reported was noted.

Chairman, Senate on behalf of the Senate approved the following:

- **Constitution of Board of Academics:**

The Board of Academics (BoA) was constituted on 20th August, 2014.

More details on the same is placed as an Annexure-2; Page - 3.

"The Deans Committee approved the Board of Academics. The role of the Board is to consider proposals on policy matters related to academics, both teaching and research. Proposals that are found to have merit will be forwarded to the Senate with the Board's recommendations. For major new proposals, the Board may prepare a white paper that is circulated to the faculty for comments. The deliberations on such a proposal will be continued in the subsequent meeting(s) considering comments received. The Board constitution is as follows:

- a) Dean (Academics) : Chair
- b) Associate Dean (Courses) : Member
- c) Associate Dean (Research) : Member
- d) Chairman Library Advisory Committee : Member
- f) Chairman Course Proposal Committee : Member
- g) Course Coordinators (one for each B.Tech, M.Tech, M.Sc, M.A. Programme)
- h) Two nominees from each School (At least one being an Assistant Professor, for a term of two years)
- l) Industry Members: 2-3 persons from relevant industries, having academic inclination
- j) Student Members: Academic Affairs Secretary, Research Affairs Secretary
- k) AR (Academics): Secretary

Initiation of Proposals

Proposals may be made in different ways:

- Any Board member may submit a well documented proposal to the Dean (Academics) for consideration.
- Anyone may submit a proposal to a School. After deliberation by the School Faculty, the proposal may be submitted to the Dean (Academics)
- Chair, Course Proposal Committee will submit all course proposals approved by CPC
- The Dean (Academics) may initiate deliberations on any issue

The Dean will vet each proposal for its relevance to the terms of reference of the Board, and ensure that it is well documented and well written. The agenda of the Board will be divided in to two parts- Part A: for consideration with student members and Part B: for consideration without student members. A proposal that comes through a School will be championed in the Board by the 2 nominees of the School. If the situation warrants, the Dean (Academics) may invite the initiator of a proposal to the meeting.

The Committee should meet at least once in a month during the semester, once during the winter vacation. Special meetings may be called more frequently if some issues warrant. The quorum of the Board shall be 2/3 or the members from IIT.

- **Introduction of Rani Gonsalves Memorial Medal**

This award is for outstanding all-round proficiency from among the female B.Tech. students graduating in a year. The details of this award are placed in Annexure-3; Page - 4.

This new award is instituted by Prof. Timothy A. Gonsalves, Director, IIT Mandi, in memory of his mother Mrs. Rani Gonsalves.

- **To report on the HTRA scholarship of PhD scholars after completion of prescribed duration.**

The grant of fellowship during the extension period to Ph.D. Scholars are as per the following rules:

For Regular Ph.D. scholars:

The Ph.D. scholars, who are not able to complete their degree within the stipulated period, may be granted an extension of one year.

During the period of extension, such scholars will be given the HTRA scholarship from the institute as given below:

Sl. No	Qualifying Degree	Scholarship During Extension period
1.	Graduate Degree in Professional Courses (BE/B.Tech. or Equivalent) and GATE or equivalent qualification OR Post Graduate Degree in Basic Sciences (M.Sc. or Equivalent) and NET qualified	50% of the last paid scholarship during the 6 th year.
2.	Post Graduate Degree in Professional Courses (M.E./M.Tech. or equivalent)	50% of the last paid scholarship during the 5 th year.

- During the extension period, the scholar will have to present the progress before the Doctoral Committee in the presence of Dean (Academics) on completion six months of extension. The approval of the Committee will be mandatory for the continuance of the scholarship beyond first six months of the extension.
- As per practice at the Institute, such Ph.D. scholars are required to perform the TA duty of 8 Hrs./week during the extension period also.

• **Implementation of reservation policy of Govt. of India in the PG programmes (M.Tech.& M.Sc.)**

The reservation policy of Government of India was implemented during the admission of M.Sc. and M.Tech. admissions. The distribution of seats for various categories for the Post Graduate Programs on the defined intake w.e.f. Academic Year 2014-15 was as follows:

Presently, the intake for M.Tech. (Energy Materials) and M.Sc. (Chemistry) has been set to 12 seats in each program.

- **Rules for refund of Fee/Charges on withdrawal from**

PG/MS/PhD programme

The rules for refund of Fee/Charges on withdrawal from PG/MS/Ph.D. program is as below:

Academic/Institute Fee:

- If the withdrawal is requested on or before the date of Registration, full fee may be refunded after deducting processing fee of Rs.1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only).
- If the withdrawal is requested after the date of Registration, only Caution/Security/Refundable deposits may be refunded (after adjusting the dues, if any).

Hostel Rent/ Charges:

- The Caution/Security/Refundable deposits may be refunded (after adjusting the dues, if any).
 - If the withdrawal is requested before taking possession of / occupying the hostel room, full rent/charges may be refunded.
 - If the withdrawal is requested after taking possession of / occupying the hostel room, the hostel charges may be refunded on proportionate deductions of monthly charges/seat rent, Mess charges, etc. where applicable.
 - Refund will be processed only if the request of withdrawal and cancellation of registration is duly approved by the Dean-Academics and the student submits the 'No Dues certificate' obtained from the concerned sections/authorities.

- Report on granting of MCM scholarship from inter-se-branch quota to B.Tech. students (General/OBC).

The following policy is adopted to grant MCM scholarship to B.Tech. students (General/OBC) on Inter-se-Branch quota i.e.

'In case there are vacancies in a branch and there are no wait-listed candidates belonging to that branch and year, then a combined merit list will be prepared of all wait-listed candidates of that year and the remaining scholarships will be distributed accordingly.'

- Report on granting of GATE scholarship to M.Tech. students:

On the recommendation of Board of Academics (BoA), the Director approved granting of GATE scholarship of Rs. 8000/- per month (tenable for a maximum period of 24 months) to the M.Tech. students (having valid GATE score at the time

of admission in the Institute. The beneficiary students of GATE scholarship are required to provide assistance of 8 hours / week in the institute.

- **Report on introduction of Vacation (Summer/Winter) Term.**

IIT Mandi introduced vacation terms from Winter 2014 onwards. Vacation courses will be offered based on need and approved by Dean (Academics). The School Chairperson will propose the name of the faculty member (with expertise in the course area), who will teach the course with the concurrence of the faculty member. Offering of these courses in the vacation term will require the final approval of Dean (Academics).

Suitable remuneration will be paid to the faculty members, as decided from time to time.

- **To report conversion of TU grades to IIT Mandi equivalent grades.**

The Chairman, Senate approved the conversion of TU Grades to IIT Mandi Grades as under:

The conversion formula $01 \text{ IIT Mandi Credit} = 1.5 \text{ ECTS}$ is approved by IIT Mandi and is used for grade computation purposes for those IIT Mandi students who go on semester exchange to foreign institutions where the ECTS system is followed. The credits of each course will be converted and then rounded off to a single decimal point using a 0.05 threshold rule.

- **Curriculum Degree Requirements of the 2011 Batch of B.Tech students: (Reporting Item presented by Assoc. Dean(Courses))**

Since the new B. Tech curriculum of IIT Mandi was introduced only in 2012, the basket-wise credit requirements for earlier batches of students (that is, students joined in the year 2009, 2010 and 2011) for their graduation had to be defined separately taking into considerations the actual courses that were taken by these students. The broad curriculum structure and objectives, however, are the same in all cases.


The basket-wise requirements for the B.Tech batches of 2009, 2010 and 2011 have
