Item No. 23.1: To confirm the minutes of the 22nd Senate meeting held on 27th June, 2019.

Item No. 23.2: To receive a Report on the action taken to implement the decisions of the 22nd Senate meeting held on 27th June, 2019.

The Senate noted the action taken on implementation of decisions taken in its 22nd meeting held on 27th June, 2019.

Item No. 23.3: To consider the new courses proposals recommended by the Course Proposal Committee (CPC) and Board of Academics (BoA):

The Senate considered and approved the following courses with modifications.

Senate noted that HS537 is up-gradation of HS471. Therefore, HS471 can now be dropped from the list of courses to be offered in future.

Item No. 23.4: To consider modification in course curriculum of M.Tech. (PED) programme:

On the recommendation of Board of Academics, the Senate considered the proposal for modification in the course curriculum of M.Tech. (PED) programme presented by Dr. Himanshu Misra. After deliberations, the Senate approved the proposal. The proposal, as approved by the Senate is enclosed as **Annexure – B, Page No. 25 to 27.**

Item No. 23.5: To consider Modification in B.Tech. CSE curriculum and Discipline Core (DC) courses:

On the recommendation of Board of Academics, the Senate considered the modified proposal of B.Tech. CSE curriculum

and Discipline Core (DC) courses presented by Dr. Dileep A.D., Course Co-ordinator (CSE). After due deliberations, the Senate approved the proposal. The proposal, as approved by the Senate is enclosed as **Annexure – C, Page No. 28**.

Item No. 23.6: To consider proposal on Independent Study Course:

On the recommendation of Board of Academics, the Senate considered the proposal on Independent Study Course presented by Dr. Sandip Saha. The Senate gave various inputs for modification of the proposal and requested the committee to rework the proposal and present it again for Senate's approval through Board of Academics (BoA).

Item No. 23.7: To consider Faculty Research & Teaching Exchange Scheme with IIT Tirupati:

A proposal to establish a long-term strategic partnership with IIT Tirupati for academic collaboration was discussed. It was noted that such a partnership will be beneficial to both the Institutes. It will help IIT Tirupati leverage the experienced faculty and unique academic culture of IIT Mandi. For IIT Mandi, a strategic relation with IIT Tirupati will be useful in establishing more industrial links with the rich industrial ecosystem in the Tirupati region. It is noted that there is significant overlap in the strategic thrust areas of the two Institutes.

After detailed deliberations, the Senate decided the following:

In order to establish a long-term relationship, frequent interaction between the faculty of both the Institutes needs to be encouraged. Currently, IIT Mandi has the Summer vacation from the middle of June to end of July and Winter vacation from December to the middle of February, while IIT Tirupati has Summer Vacation from the middle of May to end of July and Winter Vacation in December. Therefore, it is decided that IIT Mandi Faculty who wish to collaborate with the faculty of IIT Tirupati can visit during their Winter Vacation for a period of 1 to 2 months. Similarly, IIT Tirupati faculty can visit IIT Mandi during the period of their Summer Vacation. During the visit, the faculty may offer 1 or 2 credit courses at the visiting Institutions and engage in research collaborations.

The faculty intending to make such a visit must make a proposal indicating the long-term benefit to IIT Mandi that is expected to accrue. The period of the visit to the respective Institutions will be treated as on duty. The host Institution will provide free accommodation. The Senate authorized the Chairman, Senate to enter into a suitable MoU with IIT Tirupati.

Item No. 23.8: Any other Agenda item with the permission of the Chairman, Senate

- (i) A document on Academic Governance at IIT Mandi was proposed by Dr. Subrata Ghosh for Senate's approval. After detailed discussions and deliberations, the Senate approved the proposal with suggested modifications.

The final proposal as approved by Senate after incorporating the suggested changes is placed at **Annexure – D, Page No. 29 to 34.**

- (ii) Students' Academic Secretary requested that the Institute website needs to be updated regularly following various Senate decisions. It was noted that the addition of new courses to Minor or other baskets are not reflected immediately on the website. The Senate advised the concerned in-charges to do the needful in this regard.

The Senate also requested Chair, CPC to look into the possibility of documenting the allocation of courses to a particular Minor or other basket during the course approval process itself.

Item No. 23.12: To consider the policy on joint appointments for interdisciplinary academics:

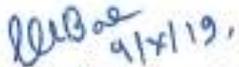
The Senate deliberated on the proposal in detail and approved the proposal with the addition of the following points to the original proposal.

- (i) Include one 'subject expert' in the Joint Appointment Committee. The subject expert can be from IIT Mandi or outside.
- (ii) The Institute has a policy of not appointing in one School husband and wife who work in similar areas. In case a faculty is already appointed in School X, his/her spouse may wish to apply for an appointment in School Y with affiliate status in School X. For convenience in advertising and selection, the spouse would apply against an advertisement in his/her area by School X. If selected, in consultation with the Chair of School Y, s/he will be offered an appointment in School Y with affiliate status in School X.

The final document after incorporating suggested changes as approved by Senate is placed as **Annexure – F, Page No. 49 to 50.**
